Nathan and Gabriela Hoppe are long-term OCMC missionaries serving in Albania under the direction of Archbishop Anastasios. Nathan was born and raised in Colombia, South America, where his mother continues to serve as a missionary. He holds master's degrees from Wheaton College and Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology and a D. Min. (Doctor of Ministry) from St. Vladimir's Theological Seminary. Nathan has served in Albania for more than 23 years. Gabriela, a native of Albania, is a graduate of the Resurrection of Christ Theological Academy and the University of Tirana; she also holds a master's degree in Children's and Family Ministry from Bethel Seminary. Gabriela is not able to join Nathan in Alaska for this trip. The Hoppes have three children. Nathan also serves on the steering committee of the Lausanne-Orthodox initiative (LOI), is a member of the Advisory Council for World Vision Albania, and is on the board of the Inter-Confessional Bible Society.
