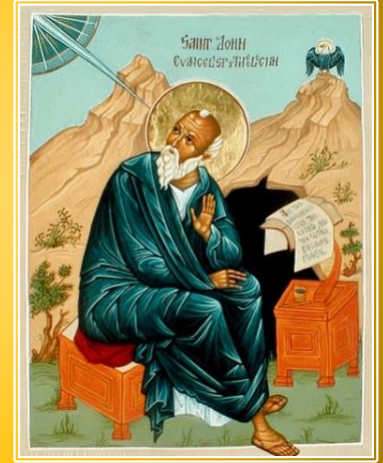

### Thanksgiving Offering

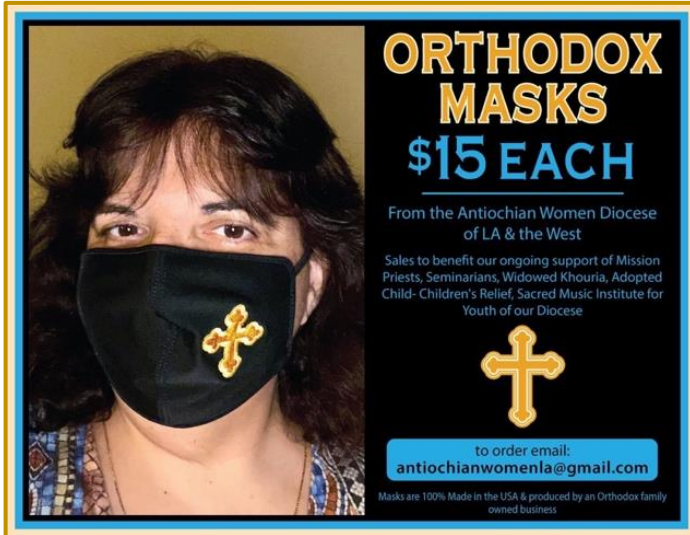

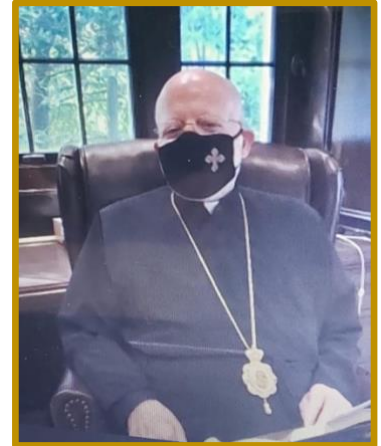

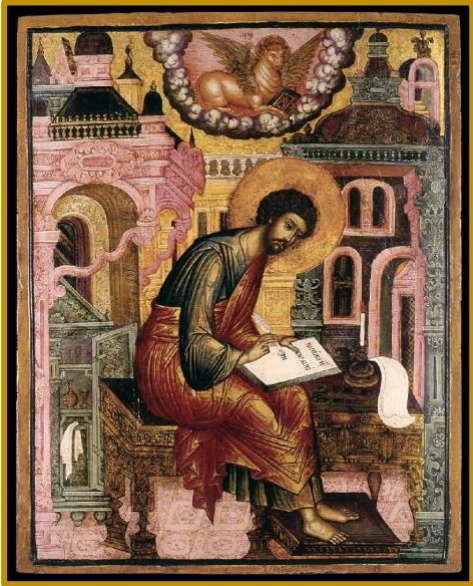

## THE SYNAXARION



### THE SYNAXARION

On October 18, in the Holy Orthodox Church we commemorate the holy Apostle and Evangelist Luke.

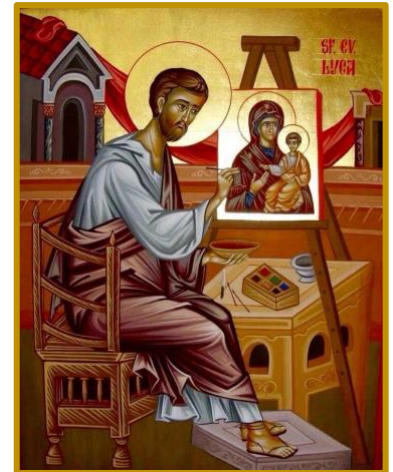
#### *Verses*

*When walking near Emmaus my eyes were kept from recognizing You, O Christ.*

*Yet now, says Luke, I see You distinctly.*

*On the eighteenth Luke reached the limit of his life.*

Luke was born in Antioch and was numbered with the Seventy Apostles. He excelled in his studies of Greek philosophy, medicine and art. Luke once came to Jerusalem where he saw the Savior face to face and with Cleopas, he saw the resurrected Lord on the road to Emmaus. After the descent of the Holy Spirit, Luke returned to Antioch and preached with the Apostle Paul and then traveled to Rome with him, converting Jews and pagans to the Christian Faith. Following the martyrdom of Paul, Luke preached the Gospel throughout Italy, Croatia, Libya, Macedonia, Egypt and Greece. He painted three icons of the Most-holy Theotokos, one of which is protected by the nuns of the Antiochian Orthodox Christian Convent of Our Lady of Sednaya in Syria. He also painted icons of the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul. Hence, Luke is considered to be the founder of Christian iconography. In addition to his Gospel which he wrote in about the year 60, Luke wrote the Acts of the Apostles and dedicated both works to Theophilus, the governor of the Greek city, Achaea. Luke was 84 years old when the wicked idolaters tortured him for the sake of Christ and hanged him from an olive tree in the town of Thebes, in Beotia, Greece. The miracle-working relics of this wonderful saint were transported to Constantinople in the fourth century.



On this day, we also commemorate Martyr Marinos the Elder at Anazarbos; Venerable Theodore, Simeon and Euphrosyne, founders of the Monastery of the Great Cave in Greece; New-martyrs Gabriel and Kyrmidoles of Egypt; and Venerable Peter of Cetinje.

By their holy intercessions, O Christ God, have mercy upon us. Amen.
