THE SYNAXARION

Elizabeth & Barbara, the New Martyrs of Russia – July 18



On July 18th, in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate the holy Martyrs Elizabeth and Barbara of Russia.

Elizabeth was the Grand Duchess and granddaughter of Queen Victoria of England and elder sister of Empress Alexandra of Russia and was one of the most illustrious women of her day, known throughout Europe not only for her high birth and graceful beauty, but also for her modesty and goodness of heart. After marrying the Grand Duke, she converted to Orthodoxy. Following the assassination of her husband in 1905, she withdrew from public life and founded the Convent of Saints Mary and Martha in Moscow, where she became Mother Superior. There she dedicated herself to prayer, fasting, tending the sick, and caring for the poor. After the Bolsheviks seized power, Saint Elizabeth was exiled to the Ural Mountains. The Novice

Barbara followed Saint Elizabeth and asked to be allowed to join her in her exile. The Bolsheviks agreed, but they said that if she chose to do so, she would face brutal torments and a violent death. To their amazement, Barbara consented. They were herded into the forest, pushed into an abandoned mineshaft, all the while singing Church hymns. The Bolsheviks then hurled in grenades, and after they left, an observer could still hear singing for some time. The last thing Elizabeth did as she lay dying in the mineshaft was to bandage the wounds of one of her companions with her handkerchief.

Their holy relics were recovered and taken to the Convent of Saint Mary Magdalene in Jerusalem. When their caskets were opened in 1981, their bodies were found to be partially incorrupt, exuding the sweet fragrance of sanctity.

Elijah the Prophet – July 20

On July 20, in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate the fiery ascent as it were into the Heaven of the holy and glorious Elijah (or Elias) the Tishbite.

Verses

He withheld the rain and thrice brought down fire from Heaven. Now Elijah parts the stream and hastens upwards. On the twentieth, O Elijah, you were caught up as a rider in a chariot.

Elijah was born in the town of Tishba in Gilead east of the Jordan River. His father Savah saw an angel of God hovering around the child,

wrapping the child in fire and feeding him a flame of fire. This foreshadowed Elijah's God-given fiery character and power. Elijah confronted the Israelite, King Ahab, and his evil wife Jezebel,

who persuaded her husband to erect a temple to the pagan god Baal. Through great miracles Elijah displayed the power and authority of the real God: he closed up the heavens so that no rain fell for 42 months; he lowered a fire from heaven and burned the sacrifice to his God which the pagan priests could not do; he accurately prophesied to Ahab that the dogs will lick up his blood and to Jezebel that the dogs will consume her flesh. Elijah took Elisha and designated him as his successor in the prophetic calling. Elijah was taken up into the heavens in a fiery chariot by flaming horses, prefiguring the universal Resurrection. He appeared on Mount Tabor with our Lord Jesus Christ together with Moses on the Transfiguration. Before the end of the world, as told in the Book of Revelation, Elijah will appear again to put an end to the power of the anti-Christ.

On this day, we also commemorate Righteous Iliya of Georgia. By the intercessions of Your Saints, O Christ our God, have mercy on us. Amen.
