

Great Vespers, Sat, Sep 6 at 7:15pm Matins/Divine Liturgy, Sun, Sep 7 at 9:15am/10am


This year the Nativity of the Mother of God falls on a Monday. We will celebrate her feast day on Sunday with our regular services of Great Vespers and Divine Liturgy.



## Placing of the Sash of the Theotokos – August 31



On August 31, in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate the Placing of the Sash of our Most Holy Lady the Theotokos in Constantinople (*Halkoprateia district*) during the reign of the emperor Theodosius the Younger.

#### Verses

Like an all-golden garland, O most honorable Virgin,

I set your sash on the year's end as an adornment.

On the thirty-first, the Sash of the All-pure Virgin was enshrined.

At her Dormition, the Most Holy Mother of God left her Sash to the Apostle Thomas. This Sash was later taken to Constantinople and kept there in a sealed case in the church of the Mother of God (at Blachernae). This case was never opened until the time of the Emperor Leo the Wise in the late ninth century. Leo's wife, the Empress Zoë, was taken sick in soul and, as the result of a mysterious vision, desired that the Sash of the Most Holy Theotokos be placed upon her. The Emperor asked this of the Patriarch, who opened the case and found the Sash completely whole and undamaged by time. The Sash was taken out and placed upon the sick Empress, who immediately recovered. They sang hymns of thanksgiving to the Most Holy Theotokos, and then returned the venerable Sash back into the case and resealed it.

On this day, we also commemorate our fathers among the saints Gennadius, Patriarch of Constantinople; Hieromartyr Cyprian, Bishop of Carthage; John, Metropolitan of Kiev; and Aidan, Bishop of Lindisfarne. By their intercessions, O Christ God, have mercy upon us. Amen.
