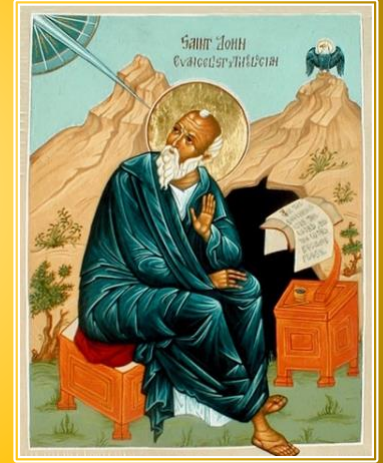

## *Feast Days and Services*

### **Advent Fast - November 15 Through December 24**

This fast is kept the same as Great Lent, except that fish, wine and oil may be eaten up to December 20. On December 20 begins the special "holy week" preceding Christmas when the fast should be more strict. (Although this fast traditionally begins on November 15, 40 days before Christmas, it is pastorally suggested that it may be kept most seriously beginning December 1. When the liturgical texts for Advent begin to appear.)

\*Salads

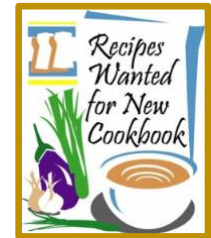

## THE SYNAXARION

Apostle Philip – November 14



On November 14, in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate the holy, glorious, and all-laudable Apostle Philip, one of the foremost and original twelve apostles.

### *Verses*

*By his feet, on a post is Philip suspended,  
repaying You for washing his feet, O Savior.  
On the fourteenth, O Philip, you were hanged upside down.*

Philip was born in Bethsaida beside the Sea of Galilee, as were Peter and Andrew. Instructed from his youth, as recorded in Holy Scripture, Philip immediately responded to the call of the Lord Jesus and followed Him. After the descent of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost, Philip zealously preached the Gospel throughout many regions in Asia and Greece. Many miracles were performed through Philip, especially the healing of the sick, by which many pagans believed in Christ. In what is now Asian Turkey, in the town of Hierapolis, Philip found himself in common evangelical work with his sister Mariamna, the Apostle Bartholomew, and the Apostle John the Evangelist and Theologian. The wicked pagans seized Philip and crucified him upside down on a tree, and then crucified Bartholomew as well. At this, the earth opened up and swallowed the judge and many other pagans with him. In great fear, the people rushed to rescue the crucified apostles, but only Bartholomew was still alive. Philip had already breathed his last. This wonderful apostle suffered in the year 86 in the time of Emperor Dometian.

On this day, we also commemorate Gregory Palamas, archbishop of Thessalonica; the New-martyr Constantine of Hydra; Justinian the emperor and his wife Theodora. By the intercessions of Your Saints, O Christ God, have mercy upon us. Amen.
